HalleluYah means praise ye Yah.

Yah is the abbreviated form for the first part of our Heavenly Father's Name.

We believe a common error among most Bible translators is the elimination of heaven's revealed Name of the Most High.

Yahweh, and the Name of His Son, Yahshua the Messiah, and substituting titles and names of local deities, expressly transgressing Yahweh's commandments.

Ex. 20:7 Thou shalt not take the name of Yahweh thy Elohim in vain; for Yahweh will not hold him guiltless that taketh his name in vain.

Ex. 23:13 And in all things that I have said unto you be circumspect: and make no mention of the name of other mighty ones, neither let it be heard out of thy mouth.

The Messiah was of the tribe of Judah.

He was a "Jew." He has a Hebrew name which has a very important meaning.

He was not a Greek Iesus or a Latin Jesus.

Yahshua means "Yah saves" or "Yah will save."

Ex. 14:13 And Moses said unto the people, Fear ye not, stand still, and see the salvation of Yahweh, which he will shew to you to day: for the Egyptians whom ye have seen to day, ye shall see them again no more for ever.

Hosea. 2:16-17 And it shall be at that day, saith Yahweh, that thou shalt call me Ishi; and shalt call me no more Baali.
2:17 For I will take away the names of Baalim out of her mouth, and they shall no more be remembered by their name.

It seems strange that almost 7,000 times in the Bible, the personal name of our Creator has been stricken out and replaced with the words LORD and GOD.
